

Connection Club membership terms and conditions

1. These terms and conditions, in conjunction with the Data Protection Notice (together "Terms"), govern the Connection Club membership scheme ("Connection Club"). The promoter of Connection Club is The Junction EPIISO 4 Antrim S.a.r.l. 1, Allée Scheffer Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg L-2520 LUXEMBOURG ("we" or "us"). Additional terms and conditions may also apply for optional elements of Connection Club membership such as competitions, prize draws or events. The Terms may be amended at any time by us and the current version will be displayed here. Membership of Connection Club is deemed acceptance of the Terms by any member or proposed member.
2. To be a member of Connection Club you must be aged 18 years or over and have a valid e-mail address, through which Connection Club is able to communicate with you. Connection Club is only for personal use by members.
3. Membership of Connection Club is entirely at our discretion and accordingly we can refuse an application for any reason. An individual may only have one active Connection Club membership. We reserve the right to refuse, merge or close additional memberships at any time. We reserve the right to monitor the number of memberships in any household, and the right to cancel any suspected duplicated memberships.
4. A member may choose to leave Connection Club at any time by contacting us, or by opting out of receiving marketing information from us.
5. The member must keep The Junction informed of any changes to your personal or membership details. We will not be responsible for any loss of vouchers or your membership card resulting from details being out of date or inaccurate.
6. We may, at any time, terminate the Connection Club membership scheme.
7. We may remove a member from the Connection Club membership at any time should we believe a member has breached the Terms or behaved in an inappropriate, misleading or abusive manner.
8. We may at our discretion decline to issue, withdraw or cancel Connection Club offers and vouchers at any time.
9. Your Connection Club membership cards, and any associated vouchers, remain the responsibility of the member, as do any security details relating to the membership. We will not be held responsible for any loss arising from the member failing to ensure their safe-keeping.
10. Connection Club Offers cannot be transferred (unless expressly mentioned in the particular offer), bought, sold or in any way traded.
11. Members must produce a valid Connection Club card, in order to receive any Offer or voucher as a participating retailer.
12. Offers or vouchers are only redeemable at the location stated, which will always be within The Junction.
13. Connection Club does not (i) take any responsibility for the offers provided by the participating retailers; and/or (ii) provide any warranties regarding the goods (including without limitation the quality thereof) that the member may obtain through the offer at the relevant participating retailer. The member shall have no right, and waives any ability he/she may have to make any claim against Connection Club in the event that a participating retailer fails to honour the Offers, and the member's only remedy under such circumstances would be to claim against the participating retailer.
14. Connection Club members may be invited to exclusive events as part of their membership, additional terms and conditions may apply to each event.
15. The Terms are governed by Northern Irish law, and are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Northern Ireland.
